

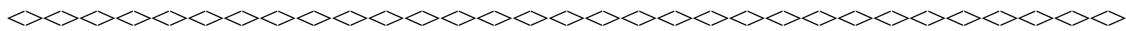


2009 HELMET ORDER FORM

- **Minimum order is twelve (12) helmets (mix of bike and multisport is OK)**
- Include only **ONE CHECK** for the total cost of all helmets.

MULTI-SPORT HELMETS - NEW THIS YEAR!!!

Safe Kids USA recommends "multisport" helmets for other wheeled sports that kids are likely to participate in. They provide extra protection for areas which are more vulnerable while using inline skates, skateboards and scooters: the back and sides of the head. If you have "multisport" kids, one of these helmets may be your best option.
