### HIV Testing

Through the Vermont Dept. of Health, testing sites offer free, anonymous (with no name) HIV counseling and testing. Several sites offer oral testing which does not require a blood sample. A few sites offer rapid testing, which enables a person to get the test result during that same appointment. Planned Parenthood sites offer confidential testing on a sliding fee scale.
